Mission: To foster and encourage mutual understanding, friendship, and peace through cultural, economic, educational and professional exchanges between the people of Jacksonville and the people of our sister cities.

Jacksonville's involvement in the Sister Cities program began in 1967, when Mayor Hans Tanzler twinned Jacksonville with Bahia Blanca, Argentina. Five other sister cities and three friendship cities were added over the years.

JSCA is governed by an all-volunteer Board of Directors. Committees are established for each of Jacksonville's sister cities to coordinate and oversee the exchanges and activities.
